

Benyovszky's Fellow-Travellers

Unless otherwise marked in the first column, the source of the information on the table is Andrew Drummond in his book *The Intriguing Life and Ignominious Death of Maurice Benyovszky* (2017); this merges name-lists from Ryumin or Sgibnev, and from Benyovszky only if verified by others.

Where **B** is shown, this refers to Benyovszky's own account, unverified by any other archival source.

Where **K** is shown in that column, this refers to the various published researches by Polish historian Edward Kajdanski, and may include some Benyovszky-only entries.

The spelling of names is taken largely from Benyovszky. Alternate spellings are those which appear in one of the other sources.
